## POST GLOBALIZATION CHANGES

- ▶ Globalization has radically altered the nature and scope of public administration.
- ▶ Globalization shifted Centre of power from the capital of the nations-state to the foreign capitals.
- ▶ Globalization has brought almost all the important states under one big umbrella, bureaucracy of each state is open to the administrative structures of other states.

## POST GLOBALIZATION CHANGES

- ▶ The internationalisation of criminal activities imposed additional burden on the activities of bureaucracy in general and that of developing nations.
- ▶ It has led to demand of opportunities and facilities by people from their own Government and due to this increased demand there is public discontent, if these demand are not fulfilled.
- ▶ The growing influence of MNC's and corporates on administration of nation-states is the breeding ground of corruption, inefficiency and dominance of market economy.
