SHORT HISTORY OF THE COLLEGE

The people of Saltora and adjoining blocks acutely felt the need of a Degree College at Saltora for a long time. As a step to that direction, a public meeting was convened in 1997 by a group of people which encouraged the organizers to proceed further for the establishment of a degree college. People from every walk of life promised all kinds of possible help. An organizing committee was constituted. It was decided that the proposed degree college be named as "SALTORA NETAJI CENTENARY COLLEGE" to show reverence and respect to our great national hero, NetajiSubhas Chandra Bose on his auspicious birth centenary. Land, money and material came in the form of donation.


The University of Burdwan granted affiliation and recognition to this co-educational institution from the session 2000–2001. The College started its journey with 58 students. At the very outset of the College, classes were held at Saltora Dr. B.C.Vidyapith. Thereafter college building was constructed and classes were shifted from Dr. B.C Vidyapith to the new campus in the month of May,2001.The college is currently affiliated to the Bankura University from the session, 2017-2018.The college is recognized under Section 2(f) & 12(B) of the UGC Act,1956.

The college is affiliated to the Bankura University and all of its activities will be conducted as per rules and regulations framed by the university from time to time and by the order of the Education Directorate, Govt. of West Bengal

LOCATION

The College is located in the lap of nature being surrounded with green hills, near Saltora – Mejia Road,

1.5 K.M. away from the Saltora Bazaar, not so far from the hills of Biharinath and Susunia.







Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme (CCFUP):

1. New Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme, UGC 2022 (as per NEP 2020) for 4-years undergraduate programme(s) with "UG Degree Programmes with Single Major" only will be maintained for the academic session 2023-2024.

2. As per New Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme, UGC 2022 (as per NEP 2020), the Undergraduate degree programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as :

i. a UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study, provided that a vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 40 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.

ii. a UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study provided that a vocational course (additional 4 credits) must be completed during the summer term by the students who will exit the programme after securing 82 credits. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven (7) years.

iii. a bachelor's degree after a 3-year (6 semesters) programme of study,

iv. a 4-year bachelor's degree (Honours) after a 4-year (8 semesters) programme of study. If the student completes a rigorous research project in their major area(s) of study in the 4th year of a bachelor's degree then (Honours with Research).

<u>Eligibility for the UG Programmes</u>:

The eligibility here is maintained for the credit structure for UG Degree Programme with Single Major only (attached herewith).

1st Year

Entry 1:- Entry requirement for 1st year 1st semester is successful completion of 10+2/ Higher Secondary (12th Grade) or equivalent stage of education from any recognized Board/Council/University.

Exit 1:- Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the first year. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years. **2nd Year**

Entry 2:- Entry requirement is a UG Certificate obtained after completing the 1st year (Two Semesters) of the UG Programme.

Exit 2:- Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 82 credits will be awarded the UG Diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the second year. These students are allowed to re-enter within a period of three years and complete the degree programme within the maximum period of seven years. **3rd Year**





Entry 3:- Entry requirement is a UG Diploma obtained after successful completion of two years (Four semesters) of the UG Programme.

Exit 3:- Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 124 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement as per the credit structure.

4th Year

Entry 4:- An individual seeking admission to a Bachelor's degree (Honors/ Honours with Research) in a specified field of learning would normally have completed all requirements of the relevant Three-year Bachelor's Degree.

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research projector dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline.

Exit 4:-

4-year UG Degree (Honours): A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 164 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements as per the credit structure.

4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research projector dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students who secure 164credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).

<u>N.B.</u>

i. The duration of the UG programme is 4 years or 8 semesters. Students who desireto undergo a 3-year UG Programme will be allowed to exit after completion of the 3rd year. If a student wantsto leave after the completion of the first orsecondyear, the student will be given a UG Certificate or UG Diploma, respectively, provided they secure the prescribed number of credits (as per the credit structure). Students who exit with a UG certificate or UG diploma are permitted to re-enter within three years and complete the degree programme.

ii. Students may be permitted to take a break from the study during the period of study but the total duration for completing the programme shall not exceed 7 years.

Additional rules regarding online admission-2023-24

1. Rules regarding admission to 1st Semester for A.Y.-2023-24 as laid down by the Department of Higher Education, West Bengal State Govt. (notification vide No.- 354-Edn(CS)/10M-95/14, dated 2nd June 2023) & Bankura University (notification Ref. No. BKU/FCUG/75A/2023, Dated 06/06/2023) will be strictly followed for online admission.

2. <u>Procedure of Admission</u> :

i) The entire admission process should be made online, strictly based on merit. Prospective students should not be called for counseling or verification of documents during the process of admission. No physical presence will be required at the College.

ii) There is no fee to apply for admission in the first semester of the academic year 2023-24.





iii) PayU Processing Charge for all online payments to be borne by the candidate.

iv) A candidate can apply or register only once for admission in the first semester of the academic year 2023-24.

v) While filling the application or registration form, applicant's permanent mobile number and permanent e-mail ID should be given very carefully. Student's User ID, password and other useful informations will be sent to the provided mobile number. In the latter case, the mobile number is the only means of communication between the students and the Bankura University.

vi) Documents to be uploaded by the students while filling up the online application:

a. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of Admit card and Mark-sheet of Madhyamik Examination.

b. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of Mark-sheet of H.S. (10 +2).

c. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of Caste Certificate (where necessary).

d. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of PH Certificate (where necessary).

e. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of Signature of candidate.

d. Scan Copy (jpg/pdf Format) of photo of candidate.

3. <u>Eligibility Criteria</u>:

- Students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination are eligible to apply for admission in the 3 years or 4-years UG Degree Programmes with Single Major.
- Students who have passed Vocational Course equivalent to 10+2 or equivalent level are eligible for admission in the 3 years or 4-years UG Degree Programmes with Single Major.

4. <u>Session Gap</u> :

For admission to the Under Graduate Course (1st year, 1st semester), there should not be a gap of more than 3 years between the year of Higher Secondary/10+2 or equivalent Examination and the year of admission to Under Graduate Programme of study i.e 2021, 2022 and 2023. In respect of calculation of marks, no deduction should be made in case of candidates passing out in previous years.

6 Candidate should read and understand the admission rules, then fill the application/registration form carefully.

7. In case of any mistake, especially if the marks obtained in Secondary and Higher Secondary are mentioned incorrectly, the entire responsibility will be on the candidate, in which case his/her admission to this college may be completely cancelled.

8. Every candidate has to choose a Single Major Subject, a Single Minor Subject and a Multidisciplinary subject at the time of admission. These Subjects are must be from different disciplines.

2. Under no circumstances, students will be admitted after the last date fixed by the BankuraUniversity.

3. Government rules in respect of reservation of seats for Scheduled caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes/Physically handicapped students will be strictly maintained.

4. The entire admission process will be processed by the Admission Committee constituted by the College Authority.

5. The College will take up the matter with the University if any admitted student of this College is found to secure admission elsewhere without prior approval.

Medium of Instruction

Medium of Instruction in the class rooms will be Bengali/English/Sanskrit/Santali. Students will have to write their answer in **Bengali/English**/Sanskrit/Santali.

Change of subjects

Change of subject (Minor/Multidisciplinary) may be done as per rule of the Bankura University (NEP-2020 regulations).

Identity Cards

Identity Cards are issued to all students who should always keep these cards in their possession for their own safety and security.

Library Cards

Library Cards issued to all the students who must use the same for borrowing library books. Library Card for students is compulsory.

Percentage of Attendance

Student reading in degree classes must have 75% percentage of attendance in order to appear at examinations as per the Bankura University guidelines.

Anti Ragging Policy of our Institution

According to the UGC Regulations (No: UGC-Rag/C/96/15/SCHE/2009) circulated on April 13.2009) ragging in our Institution is strictly prohibited and totally banned, and anyone found guilty of ragging is liable to be punished in any one or more than one way mentioned below:

- a) Cancellation of admission
- b) Suspension from attending classes
- c) Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
- d) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
- e) Withholding results





f) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival etc.

g) Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four semesters

h) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution i) Fine of Rs. 25,000/-

j) Collective punishment: when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on the potential raggers.

DISCIPLINE:

1. Irregular attendance, unjustified or unexplained absence, habitual late coming. disobedience or objectionable behavior of any kind may result in the removal of the students from the college.

2. College property willfully damaged or destroyed will be required to be made good. In addition, a heavy fine may also be imposed.

3. The use of unfair means in an examination will entail the annulment of the entire examination.

4. In case a student has any special kind of ailment /disease, the guardian must bring the same to the knowledge of the college authority.


